#### Informed Consent

- A fundamental human right designed to protect patient autonomy, self-determination, bodily integrity, and well-being
- Requires full knowledge of the risks and benefits of treatment as well as alternative treatment options
- Preferably done in conjunction with a doctor who:
  - . Understands the risks and benefits of treatment
  - Is familiar with your treatment history and clinical profile
  - Respects your personal preferences and is committed to YOUR well-being

"Do the benefits outweigh the risks for me?" Published Literature Patient










#### Conflicts of Interest

- When a party has a competing interest that might interfere with providing the best treatment to patients
- The most common is a financial conflict of interest that may occur if a party pushes a treatment because they stand to gain financially
- Other conflicts include political conflicts when a party endorses a given treatment because it will advance their political or research careers













### INDIRECT FINANCIAL CONFLICTS
